



Fire Hazard Ratings

The Fire Danger Rating is monitored from April 1st to Oct 31st.

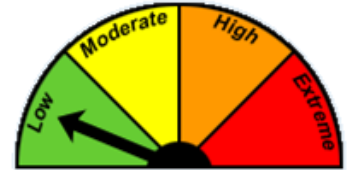
Consult with the Township of Coleman's municipal office for outdoor burning regulations, and monitor Fire Hazard Rating Signs located on Marsh Bay Road, Bass Lake Road and on Portage Bay Road.

What do the ratings mean?

LOW

Low danger of fire. You may conduct any municipally permitted fire activities.

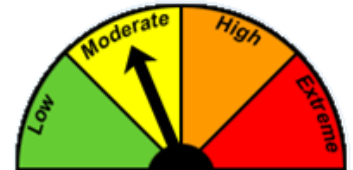
No Day Time Burning (i.e. 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.)



MODERATE

Moderate danger of fire. Carry out permitted fire activities with caution.

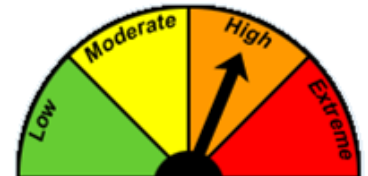
No Day Time Burning (i.e. 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.)



HIGH

High danger of fire. Only absolutely necessary municipally permitted activities should be carried out. However, it is recommended that no burning should occur. A total fire ban may be in place.

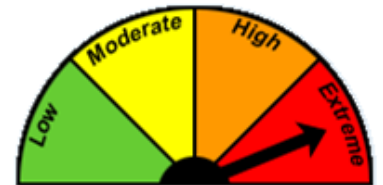
No Day Time Burning (i.e. 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.)



EXTREME

Extremely high fire danger. Absolutely no burning of any kind should be carried out. Total fire bans may be in place.

No Day Time Burning (i.e. 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.)



FIRE BAN

In some cases, should the fire danger rating be at high or extreme, the municipality may choose to issue a fire ban. When the fire ban is in place, no burning of any kind is permitted. Fireworks are not permitted.

NOTE

No person shall set out fires in open air without first obtaining a fire permit from the Coleman Township Municipal Office, with the exception of fires for obtaining warmth and cooking. No Permits shall be issued for the months of July and August in any given year.
